Valley and foothills The perfect intro to know the main species of Puerto Vallarta

This is the beginning to discover main spots of birding (from the valley to the hills), the geographical location of Puerto Vallarta surrounded by many rivers like: Mascota, Ameca, Pitilial, Rio Cuale, Mismaloya, Tomatlán, and Yelapa, which supplies with important nutrients to the estuary, mangroves and swamps. That is what make this tourist destination be one of the most important places to the bird watching where you have the opportunity to see some species like:

Social and vermillion flycatcher, woodpeckers, hummingbirds, kiskadee, White collared seedeater, Groove Billed ani, hawks, American kestrel, Yellow winged cacique, Elegant qualis, parakeets, pigeons and doves.

## SEA BIRDS AND SHORE BIRDS

During the winter, one of the most seen is the white pelican. They usually live in estuaries, ponds or lakes and also during the winter, is possible to see some petrels on the sand of the beaches.

During the year is possible to see, in a large flock brown pelicans, along the beaches and Banderas Bay.

Other species that we can see on the shores during the year are brown and blue footed boobles, gulls, terns, skimmers, sandpiper, plovers, cormorant.

The magnificent frigate bird is also one of the main species that we can see.





Marsh and ponds:

In the rivers and estuaries the most common birds that we can see are grebes, cormorants, anhinga, herons, egrets, storks, ibises and spoonbills.

## Discover Cabo Corrientes.

This is one of the most interesting tours specially designed for beginners, intermediate, advanced. Places to visit:

- "Orchid route": Las Guásimas is considered the best kept secret place in the low jungle where you can see a great variety of birds.
- \* "Pond and Estuary": VIIIa del Mar is a rich place on birds concerned. Here we have the opportunity to sall in the river on a typical panga, and watch river and estuary birds. As a recommendation, you can enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant.





The Oyster route is designed to see the difference of the environment of Cabo Corrientes that goes from the oaks and pines to the low caducifolia jungle.

- \* "Raicilla Route" is the best way to see some hawks and kits and before to end the tour, try the best traditional beverage called raicilla, made it from the blue agave with the local community
- Yelapa- Marletas Islands: Spectacular view of marine birds from the Yelapa Village, where the nature is still in good conditions because hasn't been changed. To make this tour, we need to take a boat to the Natural Protected Area of Marletas Islands.
- Las Palmas Río Mascota: Around 20 minutes driving from the airport, is located one of the mains rivers in Vallarta named Rio

Mascota, there is possible to see some birds as: Gray hawk different sparrows, common black hawk, green king fisher, hummingbirds.

Something special in addition on this tour is to take the long road to San Sebastian del Oeste and Mascota and see mountain birds in another kind of environment.

Nuevo Vallarta : Located near the Flamingos golf course it the Crocodile farm, an special place to find a perfect spot to see some pond birds. You can also ask us about the kayak trip.



These places are located at Nayarit State.

- Routes highly recommended from Puerto Vallarta to Manzanillo: Cabo Corrientes, Tomatlán, La Huerta, and Cihuatlán.
- Main sites to bird watching on this route: Cajón de Peñas Dam, Rio Cultzamala, Río Marabasco, Biosphere Reserve of Cultzmala
